„Reatching into the Rabbit Hole“ is an experimental event hosted by reatch. We want to use solid scientific knowledge to develop lofty ideas about tomorrow - in order to find sober solutions for today.

A stereotypical claim of all sorts of sciences (e.g. natural sciences, the humanities) is that they alone have a monopoly on truth and that they alone provide deeper knowledge about the world. We shall not linger over the question which form of science is superior but instead try to find a way to acknowledge the similarities and particularly stress the complementary nature of the sciences. The emphasis of the talk is put on reception, perception and interpretation of art on the one hand and, on the other hand, art's indispensable role in counter-balancing today's predominant natural science perspective of the world.
